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Introduction

St. Mary's Hospital, Korauta, **Varanasi**, established in the year 2001, is a **catholic health service organization governed by Varanasi Medical Society, a registered charitable society (464/ 91-92) under the religious jurisdiction of the Bishop of the Diocese of Varanasi**. St. Mary's School of Nursing, commenced in the year 2009 as an integral part of the hospital, aims at developing nursing care personnel who will excel as care givers especially to the poor and the deprived. Upholding ethical and indiscriminate nursing practices in conformity with the socio-cultural and religious belief, especially of catholic teaching, is the underlying principle of all our educational initiatives. The school offers course in General Nursing and Midwifery recognized by the U.P. State Medical Faculty, (No. 260/ 71-3-09/ N -16 / 2009 dt.29-01-2009) and Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi. (No.02/JUN/2009-INC)

Vision

A healthy and progressive community through affordable, comprehensive health and medical care in the rural areas of Varanasi.

Mission

Caring compassionately in order to build the lives of the rural poor in the undeveloped and deprived areas of Varanasi in eastern Uttar Pradesh by providing health and medical care at an outstanding value so that they are empowered to lead the well-being of their family and the community they live in.

Philosophy

The school believes that nursing education is to provide systematic direction and guidance to the students for the fullest development of intellectual, physical, moral, emotional, and social qualities in order to be responsible citizens of the society.

We believe that the curriculum of the School of Nursing should be based on scientific principles as well as the Christian philosophy of education, which will enable the students to gain knowledge and skill for rendering comprehensive and compassionate nursing care in the hospital and in the community.

Objectives

1. To provide quality nursing education as per curriculum laid down by INC for giving comprehensive nursing care to patients in all types of illness.
2. To develop a culture of 'caring with compassion' along with skills for integrating the principles of mental hygiene, ethical and moral code involved in the practice of nursing.
3. To develop in the trainees an awareness for holistic approach to health and to adapt affordable and eco-friendly health solutions that are essential for being "*nurse par excellence*"
4. To empower young girls to gain financial self-reliance and emerge with confidence to equate the dismal gender imbalance in her own family as well as in the community.



Application

1. Admission is carried out once a year and is opened to all eligible candidates.
2. Application form and prospectus can be downloaded on **www.varanasimedicalsociety.org** from **1st April** onwards on payment of **Rs. 600/-** in bank deposit or by **D.D.** drawn in favor of "*St. Mary's School of Nursing, Varanasi.*"
3. Application should be filled in by the candidate in her own hand writing.
4. Completed application form should reach the school office latest by **31st May** together along with copies of the following:
 - i. Pass certificate and marks obtained in +2 or its equivalent.
 - ii. T.C/Conduct certificate from the head of the institution last attended.
 - iii. Certificate of any other educational qualification if she possesses.
 - iv. Certificate of physical fitness from registered medical practitioner
 - v. Income Certificate of students and parents, caste, Residence, Ration card, Pan card, Bank Pass book and Aadhar Card with latest Updates.
 - vi. Four copies of recent passport size photographs.
 - vii. Two self-addressed and adequately stamped envelopes of 9 x 4 inches.
 - viii. A covering letter in candidates own hand-writing with the list of enclosures.
5. Incomplete applications will not be entertained. Receipt of the application form does not imply acceptance of the candidate to the Course.

Eligibility and Admission

1. Selection and admission will be based on the merits of qualifying examination, written test and personal interview.
2. Minimum educational qualification is 10 + 2 passed or its equivalent with English on first attempt with aggregate of 50% marks (*Preference will be given to students with science subject*)
3. Candidate should be single / unmarried female, 17- 25 years of age on the date of admission.
4. Eligible candidates will be informed about the written entrance test by last week of May 2024.
5. The written entrance test will cover questions from English, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology & General Knowledge.
6. There will be a personal interview for those who qualify in the written test. Originals of certificates are to be produced at the time of interview.
7. Provisionally selected candidates will be required to undergo a complete physical examination conducted by the Government doctor and School at their own expense and only those found fit will be admitted to the course.
8. Preference will be given to candidates from the State of Uttar Pradesh.
9. Only forty students are admitted every year for the said course.
10. The decision of the selection committee of the school will be final and binding.

Preliminary Training Period

The course starts usually on the **1st of August** Selected candidates who are willing to join the course are to report to the school office within **7 days** of declaration of the results and have to confirm the seat by depositing **Rs. 60000/- as advance** payable to St. Mary's School of Nursing, Varanasi. Fees once paid will not be refunded and in case a student leaves the school in the mid-course of her study she will have to deposit full course fees.

The first three months of training is called Preliminary **Training Period** at the end of which there will be an examination, and the successful candidates will receive their uniform and continue their studies. The unsuccessful candidates are given a second chance and if they are found unfit, they will not be allowed to continue their studies.

Course Outline & Medium

The Diploma Course in General Nursing and Midwifery extends over a period of three years leading to an 'A' grade nursing certificate. Medium of instruction in the school is English.

Examination & Certificates

There will be three Public Examinations held by the Government of Uttar Pradesh Board of Examination. Each examination is held after completion of 12 months of Theory and clinical practice. The minimum marks required for passing any examination in Nursing is 50%. No candidate is allowed to sit for examination if her attendance is less than 85%. The school conducts selection examination one month before the common board examinations.

The percentage of class room and clinical attendance, general conduct of the student and the performance in the clinical area, are taken in to consideration for the selection examination. As the course is recognized by both **State Nursing and the Indian Nursing Council**, certificates issued to the successful candidates can be registered with **the Nurses and Midwives council** of any state in India and enable the nurse, to practice as an 'A' grade registered Nurse and Midwife.

E- Bio Metric Attendance

Students are expected to do Biometric of the face & Thumb daily morning & evening so management is not responsible for the less attendance and which is linked to the U.P. State Medical Faculty and Scholarship too.

Vacation and Leave

- Students are eligible for annual leave as prescribed by Indian Nursing Council.
- Students are allowed to avail ten days sick leave per annum on medical ground (if direly needed) which has to be certified by a registered medical practitioner.
- Any leave taken over and above this, have to be made up by the student after the completion of the regular course.
- Leave is granted in case of serious illness or death of father or mother, the authenticity of which should be certified reliably. All such special leaves will have double makeup and authorized medical certificate has to produce on rejoining time compulsory.
- Leave for festivals, wedding, etc., will not be granted.

Withdrawal and Dismissal

1. If any student decides to withdraw voluntarily from the school after the preliminary period or any time before completing the course, she should make good all the expenses incurred on her by the school.
2. The school reserves the right to send away any student whose work or conduct is not found satisfactory during the period of training.

Diploma & Registration

The Diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery is issued to successful candidates, only after they have completed the full course, which shall commence after the declaration of the qualifying examination conducted by the State Medical Faculty.

Association

Students are expected to become members of the student nurses association and the Catholic students are also expected to be members of the Catholic Nurses' Guild. Annual membership fees are payable by members as given in the fee schedule.



GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All the students are expected to reside in the hostel provided by the school.
2. Students are directly under the direction of the Principal of the School of Nursing with the cooperation of the class co Ordinator.
3. Students must be punctual for all the activities.
4. Students are expected to comply with the rules and regulations of the School, the Hostel and the Hospital.
5. Students' performance will be evaluated periodically, especially before promotion or appearance for State Board Examination.
6. The students will appear for the examinations conducted by the U. P. State Medical Faculty, at the end of each year. For the State Board Examinations, students must obtain a minimum of 50% marks in the internal examinations.
7. Any student, failing more than twice in any of the examinations, or her clinical performance, will be advised to leave the school.
8. All students must wear the prescribed Identity card and uniform of the hospital.
9. Students abstaining from duty without prior permission from the principal or her deputies will be guilty of misconduct.
10. Students are permitted to use strictly only the cell phones provided by the school. Emergency or special calls will be considered discretely in the school.
11. Students are not allowed to keep mobile phones during the entire period of study and training.
12. Students are permitted for a month of vacation per year. Leave taken for other than above mentioned reasons, should be compensated by two days for a day's absence. Shortage of attendance in any year shall be compensated in the same year during your holidays.
13. Students will be asked to replace or compensate for loss or damage caused to equipments.
14. Students may be dismissed at any time, for misconduct, disobedience, inefficiency or repeated serious negligence of duty.
